

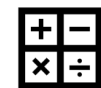
Literacy

In Literacy children will learn how to hold a book correctly, handle with care and turn pages from front to back. They will know language including author and illustrator. Children will be able to write their first name and begin to write individual letters to convey meaning.



Understanding the World

Children will look at how they have changed and developed since they were babies and discuss their families. They will learn about Ellington and observe seasonal changes in our local environment.



Maths

This term we will revisit and consolidate our knowledge on number, ensure all children can confidently count to and back from 10. We will also begin to look at the composition of numbers to 10 and what different representations of numbers may look like. We will look for different numbers in our local environment.

Children will be using a range of apparatus to learn how to safely climb, balance and hold a position. They will also hold scissors and a pencil correctly.



Expressive Art & Design

Children will be able to explore a range of resources and decide what to make. They will be able to make marks with a range of tools. They will be encouraged to act out familiar stories using small world props. The children will also explore using musical instruments to keep a beat.



Personal, Social & Emotional Development

Children will discuss being unique and being a member of our class. We will talk about rules and getting ourselves dressed. Children will also learn about the importance of good oral hygiene.
