



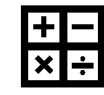
Literacy

Through our topic 'Out and About', we will work on our understanding of stories by commenting, predicting and deducing information using what we have read. We will understand that the structure of fiction and non-fiction books are different. We will offer our opinions about stories and poems including on characters. We will engage in conversations about what we have read including answering questions.



Understanding the World

We will look at London landmarks, name them and locate them on a picture map. We will understand what a monarch is and learn about King Charles III. We will discuss our community and compare our community with London and Morocco. We will identify London and Morocco on a map and look at the different cultures found in these places.



Maths

This term we will be counting and recognising numbers to 20. We will work on sharing equally between groups of 2 and 3. We will explore adding and subtracting by counting on or back. We will also explore money and how we use it as well as 3D shape.

Communication and Language

Children will begin to understand what a question is and how to ask and answer them appropriately to gain understanding. We will use sentences containing connectives such as because, and, so and but to connect ideas. We will begin to use our imagination to create stories with increasing detail.

Physical Development

Children will know and talk about the factors that support their overall health and well-being. We will continue to develop and refine our ball skills including throwing, catching and kicking. We will continue to strengthen our fine motor skills to develop strong foundations for handwriting to enable us to form most letters correctly. We will navigate apparatus safely both indoors and outdoors.



Expressive Art & Design

This term children will explore water colour paints and natural materials to make patterns and pictures. They will act out stories that are beyond their first hand experiences. We will listen and respond to music from other countries and play instruments with increasing control.



Personal, Social & Emotional

We will look at what it means to be a safe pedestrian by completing a walk in our local area. We will talk about our families and how they are special as well as other people who are special to us. We will understand the importance of sharing and explore diversity by thinking about similarities and differences.
