Maths:

Foundation Subjects:

- Science: Find out about the movement of the moon. Watch BBC video ["The moon and its orbit around Earth"](#). Draw and label a diagram of the Earth and Moon orbiting the sun or make a moon fact sheet using the template in 'Busy things' in School 360. You could also watch ["What does the moon look like and why?"](#) and find out about the phases of the moon. Try the yummy ["Oreo" task](#) and send a photo before you eat them!
- History: Watch the BBC bitesize [video](#) about Village life at West Stowe. Draw and label a picture of an Anglo-Saxon village. Write about one Anglo-Saxon job (you could make it like a vacancy advert).
- Art/DT: See if you can build an Anglo Saxon house from materials around the house. The boy in [this video](#) has a good example of how it could be done.
- French: Practise talking about yourself – see if you can say your name, age, where you live and a favourite hobby. Can you join the sentences together?
- PE: Practise passing a ball to someone at different speeds, with different kinds of balls, both throwing and kicking.
