## ⊠∃ Maths

Children begin every maths lesson with their 20-minute CLIC session (Counting, Learn Its, It's Nothing New and Calculation). The focuses for this half term will be Big Math's Wider Maths, specifically Amounts and Shape. Children will learn about amounts of temperature, time and turns, 2D / 3D shapes and position and direction.
