

English

This half term we are continuing with our non-fiction study. We have read 'Mrs Mole, I'm Home' by Jarvis. We have gathered lots of information about moles and now we are going to write our own fact file about a different animal. For the second half of this half term we are going to be focusing on writing our own letters. We will also continue learning and recapping on spellings, grammar and punctuation.

Science

In Science Year 1 will identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals. They will also identify and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.

Maths

We will continue with our learning on addition and subtraction and understand what is meant by inverse operations. We will continue revising our number facts to 10 and then increasing this to number facts within 20. We will look at numbers 11-19 in more detail and then use a ruler to measure. We will begin measuring in cm and using rulers accurately. During this half term we will have a large focus on our 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

History

In this topic, we will learn that it is much easier to get around as we have many more modes of transports now. We will look at when particular modes of transport were invented and plot these onto a timeline. We will also look further into how the trains, cars and air transport has changed over the years.

Art

This half term we will design, draw, craft, paint and art appreciation; undertaking two different printing techniques, using 2D shapes to explore a variety of media, mixing different shades of one colour and discussing the work of artist Louis Wain.

PSHE

We will continue our learning on Safety and the Changing body. We will learn about what substances we can and cannot put in/on to our bodies and how to stay safe at home. We will then move onto citizenship. In this unit we will learn why it is important to follow rules, discuss the needs of animals and babies, understanding the similarities and differences of peoples and why voting is a fair way of making a decision.
