

English

This half term, our focus texts for reading will be The Iron Man by Ted Hughes and the Abominables by Eva Ibbotson. In writing, we will be creating rhyming poems, as well as working on character descriptions and persuasive writing.

Science

We will be finding out all about rocks, including how they are formed, how they can be grouped and how fossils are made.

French

We will learn some animal names, and how to say 'je suis' ('I am')

Maths

We will start the half term with a short unit on right angles, followed by several weeks of work on the relationship between addition and subtraction, and securing a variety of mental methods to help with these calculations.

Geography

We will be learning about human and physical Landmarks of the World. They will include The Colosseum, The Great Wall of China and The Great Barrier Reef.

Design & Technology

This half term we will be 'Constructing a castle'. We will design and build a castle from recycled materials. Our focus is on making a strong and stable structure.

PSHE

We will learn how to look after our own health and wellbeing, including the importance of a healthy diet, relaxation and mindfulness.
