

English

In reading, we will continue with *Private Peaceful* and then move on to *Once* and *The Graveyard Book*. Writing will cover a range of texts including a diary entry based on The "Highwayman" and a balanced discussion inspired by *The Arrival*. We will also develop our abilities in writing to entertain based on *The Graveyard Book* by Neil Gaiman.

Science

Pupils will learn how light travels and how animals (including humans) see objects as well as completing a sustainability unit on light pollution.

French

We will learn how to describe clothing and what they are wearing.

Maths

We will continue to build on our fractions work as well as exploring percentages, decimals, ration and proportion. We will also be exploring BODMAS and revising data and graphs as well as looking at 2D and 3D shapes and their nets.

History

They investigate how the Maya settled in the rainforest, their religious beliefs, homes and what archaeological remains tell us about Maya cities.

Art & Design

Exploring art with a message, children will look at the famous 'Guernica' by Picasso and create their own artworks that speak to the viewer.

PSHE

We will continue our work on health and well-being and moved onto our unit on safety and the changing body.
