

This half term will start with a book study of 'Leaf Man'. We will complete 2 pieces of published writing in this unit. We will create a character description using adjectives and full sentences thinking carefully about correct grammar and punctuation for Year 1. We will then create a set of instructions on how to create your own 'Leaf person'. We will then carryout work on the visual text 'Kevin the Carrot'. We will continue to work on our handwriting and full stops, capital letters and finger spaces.



In Science, we will do a week study on seasonal changes for Autumn. We will then move onto the unit 'Materials'. During this unit we will explore and talk about materials and their properties before moving onto some investigations; testing different materials, sink/float, freeze/melt and testing which materials absorb water.

Maths lessons will continued to be structured following our new maths scheme 'Big Maths'. Each lesson will start with a CLIC session followed by the main session focusing on one of the following subjects; shape, amounts, fractions and exploring data (SAFE). In shape we will be looking at symmetry and finding symmetrical patterns and objects then working with 2d and 3d shapes.

History

Looking at personal chronology and finding out about the past within living memory. By examining photographs and asking questions, children investigate chronology. Beginning to look at a simple timeline extending back to before they were born.



Art

Developing observational drawing skills when exploring mark-making. Children use a range of tools, investigating how texture can be created in drawings. They apply their skills to a collaborative piece using music as a stimulus and investigate artists Bridget Riley and Zaria Forman.



We have now completed our Family and Relationship unit of work and have moved onto Health and Wellbeing. In this topic we will discuss: emotions and how to deal with them; the important of sleep; understand how rest and relaxation can have positive affects on our bodies and also how to wash germs away effectively.



Music

Pulse and Rhythm:

Clap the rhythm of their name.

Clap in time to music.

Sing the overall shape of a melody. Play in time to music.

Copy and create rhythms based on word patterns.



E-safety—Online bullying and how we should behave online. Moving a robot—Combine forwards and backwards commands to make a sequence. Plan and create a simple program for a floor robot

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This term PE taught by Mr Robertson will focus on Hands—catching and throwing. PE taught by Mrs Horsley will focus on Jumping— how and why.
