We are going to complete our initial unit of work on Fractions, as well as focusing later in the term on 2D and 3D shapes, parallel and perpendicular lines, compass points, different units of measurements and charts and graphs.

★ French

We will learn the names of 10 animals in French, and find out how to use the phrase 'Je suis' (I am) in sentences.

History

We will be finding out about life in the Stone Age, Bronze age and Iron Age, discovering what has changed between these time periods and taking part in practical workshops.

Art & Design

We will be comparing 2D and 3D art, and planning and creating abstract sculptures using different joining techniques.
