We will be finishing our unit on fractions before progressing to properties of shape. In this unit we will be exploring regular and irregular polygons, 2-D and 3-D shapes, and solving problems regarding shapes. We will then learn to measure angles using a protractor, drawing our own angles correctly and also to calculate angles on straight lines and around a point.



Geography
