

Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 4 Fiver Challenge – Whitehouse Farm

As you will no doubt be aware, the Year 4 class worked extremely hard in the ‘Fiver Challenge’ last month and raised a fantastic profit. They have chosen to use their profit towards a trip to Whitehouse Farm, Morpeth.

We are delighted to have organised this for Thursday 21st July for all Year 4 children.

The school is subsidising the transport, however due to the current cost of fuel, there is a deficit. To enable the trip to go ahead, we are asking for a contribution of £7 per child.

Children will be transported by coach from school to Whitehouse Farm at 9:15am and will return to school by 3pm. All children should be dropped off and picked up at the usual school times.

Children will require a packed lunch and drink for the day (no glass bottles/**no nut products** please). Children should come to school in uniform as normal. In addition they will need clothing and footwear appropriate for the farm and weather forecast. If sun is forecast please apply sun cream before your child comes to school and pack them a cap / sun hat. They should also bring spare sun cream with them.
