



## English

In reading lessons, we will finish reading Matilda, and we will go on to write some persuasive letters inspired by Miss Trunchbull. We will also read 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes. We will produce informative writing based on 'Stone Age Boy' by Satoshi Kitamura linked with our history topic, as well as working with the Michael Morpurgo poem 'Coming Home'.



## Science

We will be completing our biology unit of work by finding out about movement. We will then learn about nutrition and diet, and think about food waste as part of a linked sustainability unit of work.



## Maths

We are going to complete our initial unit of work on Fractions, as well as focusing later in the term on 2D and 3D shapes, parallel and perpendicular lines, compass points, different units of measurements and charts and graphs.



## French

We will learn the names of 10 animals in French, and find out how to use the phrase 'Je suis' (I am) in sentences.



## History

We will be finding out about life in the Stone Age, Bronze age and Iron Age, including a trip to the Great North Museum to enrich this topic.



## Art & Design

We will be comparing 2D and 3D art, and planning and creating abstract sculptures using different joining techniques.



## PSHE

We will learning about our Health and Wellbeing, including thinking about diet and dental health, how to build up our resilience and learning relaxation techniques.
