

# RECEPTION CURRICULUM MAP



This term we will recognise 2D and 3D shapes and look at pattern, mass, distance and money. Children will begin to learn double and halves using our fingers to support. We will also look at counting one more and one less.

#### **Communication and Language**

Children will begin to understand time and sequence concepts such as first, then and next. We will be confident to speak in front of our whole class and describe in detail what we see and know.

## **Physical Development**

Children will use threading activities to strengthen their fine motor skills. This will enable us to work on using scissors to cut out by turning the paper and hold a pencil effectively. We will continue working on handwriting families.



### Expressive Art & Design

Children will be able to mix primary colours to create secondary colours using powder paints. We will learn about floating and sinking to enable us to create a 3D boat for the Gingerbread Man. We will take on the role of a character in a familiar story and learn a dragon dance.

Children will be able to say why they feel as they do, to know that we learn from our mistakes and to listen and follow instructions carefully. Children will be able to join in with daily routines independently.
