

English

Our reading text will be Clockwork by Phillip Pullman where the children will expand their vocabulary whilst developing their retrieval and inference skills. Our writing stimuli will consist of The Island (picture book), Nelson Mandela – Little People Big Dreams Series (non-fiction) and The Alchemist's Letter.

Science

This half term we will be working on the physics element of science where our unit is 'Space'. Children will explore the solar system, planets and the moon.

Maths

Children begin every maths lesson with their 20-minute CLIC session (Counting, Learn Its, It's Nothing New and Calculation). The focuses for this half term will be Big Math's Wider Maths, specifically fractions.
