Reading Workshops

Dear Parents/Carers,

As you may be aware from reading our newsletter, we would like to invite you in to see a bit more about how we teach reading at Ellington Primary School.

You will have the opportunity to go into class with your child and sample part of either a phonics or reading lesson. In phonics, staff will go through our daily "Speed Sounds" lesson and also begin to explore their book for that week. In reading, you will join in with reading and answering questions about the class novel, so you can see the level of questioning that occurs.

We kindly ask that you let staff continue with their lesson as normal and any questions can be discussed with myself in the short meeting in the hall that will follow.

Due to space, we have spread the days out according to key stages:

- EYFS Monday 9th October
- KS1 Tuesday 10th October
- KS2 Wednesday 11th October

On the day, please arrive in school at 8:40am with your children and come into the classroom. We will register the children, who - if in a phonics group - can then lead you to where their lessons are held. Myself and Mr Hodgson will come and take you to the short meeting following the lesson.

We are really looking forward to welcoming you all into school and showing you how we learn.
