Whilst Mrs Milne is on maternity leave, Mrs Horsley will take over as Early Years lead.

Following the departure of Miss Gray, I am delighted to announce that Mrs Sanders has been appointed as one of our Assistant Headteachers alongside Mr McConville. Mrs Sanders joined Ellington in September 2022 and has had a huge impact in her time here.

We are very pleased to announce some new appointments. Miss McNickle will be joining the team at Ellington, teaching in Year One. We also have Mr Everett joining us working predominantly in Year 6 as a Higher-Level Teaching Assistant but also working across year groups.
