English

To begin this half term we are going to focus on some basic skills. We will have a big focus on letter formation and handwriting. We will also do list, caption and sentence writing. We will be studying the book 'Room on the Broom' where we will perform the story and then write it. We will then complete a non-fiction study. We will read 'Mrs Mole, I'm Home' by Jarvis. We will gathered lots of information about moles and write our own fact file about an different animal.



In Science Year 1 will continue their learning about Materials. They will investigate melting, freezing, floating and sinking.

The children will then move onto 'Animals'. Within this unit of work we will look at mammals, amphibians, birds , fish and reptiles. We will then group animals and talk about the different diets; carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.

Maths lessons will continued to be structured following our new maths scheme 'Big Maths'. Each lesson will start with a CLIC session followed by the main session focusing on one of the following subjects; shape, amounts, fractions and exploring data (SAFE).

Shape will focus on recognising and finding 2d and 3d shapes. There will be a new focus on recognising different triangles.

Amounts will follow on from last term looking at volume, capacity, weight and coins.

Fractions will continue working on finding halves, thirds and using fingers to double numbers without crossing the 10.

History

What is the weather like in the UK? Within this unit we will look at the 4 different countries in the UK. We will then look at the cities that make up the UK. We will be keeping a daily weather record and finding out more about hot and cold places in the UK.
