

## English

During this term, children in our Reading Comprehension group will be continuing their work on the book *The Worst Witch* and others will continue with their phonics programme. In English lessons, we will be letters to persuade the crayons to come back based on our story 'The Day the Crayons Quit'. We will also be learning about different types of sentences including questions, statements and exclamations.

## Science

In Science we will be continuing our work looking at Plants and their relationship with light and dark, by finding out the results of our experiment. We will also finish our topic looking at what animals need to survive.

## Maths

This term we will focus on reading bar charts and pictograms before we continue to consolidate our learning on addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will count in a range of ways and specifically focus on ways that will include crossing 1000. We will work on our times tables.

## Geography

Our big question in Geography is 'Why is our world wonderful?'. We will be learning about the world's wonders, the names and locations of the world's oceans and considering what is unique about the local area.

## Design & Technology

Labelling and constructing a wheel, looking at existing products, building a structure with a rotating wheel.

## PSHE

We will continue our unit in PSHE, 'Safety and the Changing Body' where we will end the topic by learning about road safety. We will then begin to look at our next topic 'Citizenship' where we will look at how we become great members of society.
