

English

- Write a diary entry about one of the days that you have been off school.
- Practise your handwriting: choose one of your favourite books, pick a page and copy it out in your neatest writing on lined paper.
- Practise common exception words on Spelling Shed.

Maths

- Play on Times Table Rockstars and Active Learn.
- Practise telling the time to the nearest 5 minutes.
- Continue to learn your 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
- Play 'shops' using real coins to make the amount you need to pay.

Science

- Look for minibeasts in your garden. Keep a record of what you find and where they were living (their 'micro habitats').

D & T

- Do some cooking with an adult- take a photo to show us what you made.
- Use a paper plate or cardboard to make a mask of either a story character or an endangered animal.

Art

- Draw or paint a picture of the endangered animal that you found out about.
- If it's ok with an adult, decorate a hard boiled egg- take a photo to show us.

Reading

- Share a book everyday, talk about what is happening and make predictions. Look for common exception words in the books you read.

For the whole week, be kind, be good, be helpful, tidy up your bedroom, go to bed on time – generally be nice to your parents!

- Find out about the Easter story. Record your findings in writing or as a picture with captions.
