I would also like to inform you that the governors of the school have completed a whole-school staffing restructure in light of the financial situation in which it finds itself, which is not unlike the situation faced by many schools locally and nationally. It is a situation that has been compounded by a fluctuating number of children on the school roll, due in part to families opting to move their children to alternative school partnerships and accessing specialist provision for those with additional needs, and has led to a reduction in our current level of support staff.

The governors and I have always valued the work of our support staff, the quality of which is of the highest standard, and we are sad that this situation has occured. We do nevertheless have to work within the budget that is available to us, which is not sufficient to sustain our current level of staffing.

I would like to reassure you, however, that all the services that we currently offer, including Breakfast and After-School clubs, will be continued after Easter.
