Literacy

In Literacy we will learn to continue a rhyming string and generate rhymes when asked. We will use our phonics skills to read and understand texts. We will work on writing labels and write a simple recount of the life cycle of chicks. We will continue to work on writing our first and second names independently.



We will look at how farming has changed over time in history. We will learn about farms and compare them to our local area including drawing maps. We will hatch chicks and learn about their lifecycle. We will learn about the Easter story.

This term we will learn on doubles and halves. We will look at comparing distance and mass using key vocabulary. We will look at naming coins and playing shops. We will also work on subitising within 5 and learning number bonds to 5.

Communication and Language

Children will begin to explore what an adjective is. We will learn vocabulary linked to farming, growth and healthy eating. Children will explore non-fiction texts and use vocabulary linked to them. We will look at poetry and learn a poem to recite using rhyme.



Physical Development

We will focus on balancing beanbags on our bodies and throwing and catching a ball. We will work on our teamwork skills. Children will be able to sit correctly at a table and use a pencil effectively. We will continue to work on our cutting skills to help us cut a square by turning the paper. In our handwriting, we will continue to work on handwriting families and forming letters correctly.



Expressive Art & Design

This term children will complete observational drawings of our chicks when they hatch. We will learn how to safely use a needle and thread and split pins. We will use costumes to support our role play. In computing we will learn how to draw pictures using technology.



Personal, Social & Emotional Development

This term we will focus on recognising how our friends are feeling and having strategies to support our friends when they need it. We will learn the importance of treating others with respect. We will also know the difference between healthy and unhealthy foods and explore personal hygiene through the book Whiffy Wilson.
