YEAR 3 CURRICULUM MAP SPRING TERM 1



We will start the half term developing our written column methods for addition and subtraction with 3-digit numbers. Later in the half term, we will consolidate our work last term on fractions, starting to look at decimal equivalents for tenths. We are focusing on the 4 times table.



We will work towards answering the question 'Who lives in Antarctica?' by studying its climate, where in the world it is and looking at the life of Ernest Shackleton.



□ Computing

We will learn all about coding. The children will use flowcharts to plan a program and create an interactive scene. They will also learn the importance of debugging.

Design & Technology

This half term we will be 'Constructing a castle'. We will design and build a castle from recycled materials. Our focus is on making a strong and stable structure.



We will be learning pentatonic melodies and composition skills with the theme of 'Chinese New Year'.

We will focus on dance this half term completing a unit of work called 'Wild Animals'. We will also be going swimming each week.

PSHE

We will learn about safety and the changing body, including work on cyberbullying, bites and stings and being safe near roads.



We will be focusing on Islam. By the end of the unit we will aim to answer the enquiry question: How do festivals and worship show what matters to a Muslim?
