Maths

Our main focus for this half term will be amounts and explaining data. During amounts, children will explore, distance, mass, money, temperature and time. During explaining data, children will explore diagrams, tables, bar charts, line graphs, pie charts, pictograms and probability.

History

Our topic will be 'The Greeks' and we will be exploring what impact the Greeks had on modern day Britain.

Art & Design
Throughout our unit 'Drawing: I need space' children will develop skills in evaluating images and creating art through various drawing processes.
