The Nursery and Reception classes in our school have been developed with the educational needs of the three to five-year old's as their priority. (They deliver the Foundation Stage of the Curriculum). Children enter nursery in the term after their third birthday for five half days per week or for a full 30 hours. During their time in Nursery, they will experience a detailed and highly developed curriculum tailored to the needs of the very young child.

Their stay at school can be extended to full time i.e. five full days if they meet the government criteria set out [here](#). The staff will provide an extended curriculum in line with the government's Early Learning Goals and the National Curriculum.

With the excellent environment, fluidity of movement and highly structured learning situations, we feel your children will experience an outstanding introduction to their education. Our dedicated, well trained and experienced staff enthusiastically provide quality education for all children.

Any families wishing to register their child for a place after their third birthday, are most welcome to visit our school to experience the warm and open welcome offered to all our families.

In the case of over subscription, criteria for admission in every age group will be applied in line with the Local Education Authority's Admissions Policy.
