During this term, children in our Reading Comprehension group will be continuing their work on the book Harry the Poisonous Centipede, before we begin reading The Worst Witch, and others will continue with their phonics programme. In English lessons, we will be writing newspaper reports based on the picture book 'Traction Man' by Mini Grey. We will then move on to writing a setting description based on the story 'The Tin Forest' by Helen Ward.

Science

Maths

This term we will focus on working with number including with 3 digits. We will begin to count in 100s and 1000s. We will continue working on our addition and subtraction skills, as well as beginning to solve more complex division problems.
