+-×÷ Maths

We will continue to work on fractions, demonstrating understanding of unit and non-unit fractions. We will complete the term with units of work on shape, measures and telling the time.

▲ French

We will learn the names of 10 fruits in French, and how to say whether we like or do not like them.

History

We will be using primary sources to find out about Egyptian beliefs, including beliefs about the afterlife. We will investigate pyramids, gods and goddesses, and mummified people.

Art & Design

We will develop design and craft skills, taking inspiration from our history topic to learn about Ancient Egyptian art, pattern and paper making.

PSHE

We will focus on economic wellbeing: this includes learning about budgeting, different paying methods, the emotional impact of money and the ethics of spending. We will also have a lesson to prepare us to transition into Year 4.
