

English

Our reading text will be War Horse by Michael Morpurgo where the children will expand their vocabulary whilst developing their retrieval and inference skills. Our writing stimuli will consist of Rock, Paper, Scissors (animation), The Nowhere Emporium (fiction) and The Walrus and the Carpenter poetry).

Science

This half term we will be exploring 'Earth & Space' where we will use the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky.

French

We will be learning how to talk about members of our Family.

Maths

Our main focus for this half term will be fractions. Children will recognise equivalent fractions, convert between improper fractions and mixed numbers and compare / order fractions greater than one. We will then progress to add and subtract fractions (including mixed numbers), multiplying unit and non-unit fractions before calculating fractions of amounts.

History

Our topic will be 'The Tudors' and we will be exploring what life was like during Tudor England.

Art & Design

Throughout our 'Every Pictures Tells A Story' unit, we will be analysing and evaluating work from famous artists.

PSHE

Our unit 'Citizenship' will include the law, rights / responsibilities, protecting the planet and parliament.
