

English

This half term, we will continue to read 'How to Train Your Dragon' by Cressida Cowell, which we are loving so far! Our written work will be inspired by a range of sources, including the animations 'The Girl and the Robot' and 'The Blue Umbrella'. We will also get a little taste of some Shakespeare as we create work based on an extract from Macbeth.

Science

We will be finding out all about plants this half term, including describing the functions of different plant parts, investigating how they transport water and finding out about their life cycle.

Maths

We will continue to work on fractions, demonstrating understanding of unit and non-unit fractions. We will complete the term with units of work on 2D shapes with parallel and perpendicular sides, and time.

French

We will learn the names of 10 fruits in French, and how to say whether we like or do not like them.

History

We will be finding out why the Romans settled in Britain. This will include finding out about the invasion, the Roman army and the Roman legacy in Britain.

Art & Design

We will be learning about craft. We will explore different techniques to be used with materials, such as tie-dying and weaving.

PSHE

We will be learning about economic wellbeing. We will find out about ways of paying, budgeting, how our spending affects others and about jobs and careers.
