

For reading, we will read the action-adventure story *Podkin One Ear*. We will also be writing to entertain by writing an alternative narrative based on *The Lion, The Witch and the Wardrobe*. We will also be writing to persuade by writing a letter arguing against the deforestation of the Australian Rainforests.



We will be covering a unit on habitats including by looking at classification keys and the impact that humans have on a variety of habitats.

#= **Maths**

This half term will start off by focussing on telling the time. We will then revisit formal written methods for the four operations. We will return to fractions including by learning to count in hundredths and fifths. The children will also progress their learning by starting to learn equivalent decimals to fractions e.g. 1/2=0.5.
