


The School day and routines.

Our school day begins with registration at 8:45am with the doors opening at 8:40am.

The school day ends at 3:15pm.

Our Nursery sessions run from 8:45am - 11:45am (Morning session) and 12:15pm - 3:15pm (Afternoon session) and 8:45am - 3:15pm for full day sessions.



Attendance

In order for children to achieve their full potential, it is essential that they attend school regularly. The expectation is that children will attend for at least 96% of the time, taking into account illness. We work closely with our Eduction Welfare Officer and if a child's attendance becomes a concern we will inform parents/carers and meet with them to try and resolve the situation. However, if progress is not made, the Governors will be informed and the process may become official.

School Uniform

- > Navy blue jumpers/cardigans
 - > White polo-shirts/shirt.
- > Black or charcoal skirt, shorts or trousers.
 - > Blue gingham summer dress.
 - > Black school shoes



PEKit

All classes will have two PE lessons per week from September as part of our active school approach. Initally your child's PE day will be on a Monday but we will introduce a second lesson later in the year. Children need to come to school wearing their PE kit so that they are ready for their lesson.

This avoids wasting valuable time.

Children must wear:

> School PE Kit consisting of a white t-shirt with embroidered badge and navy/black shorts

Or

- > Plain white t-shirt and plain navy/black shorts.
 - > Plain navy jogging bottoms.
 - > School PE hoody or plain navy hoody.
- > Children can wear any comfortable trainers on their PE day.



Reading in Reception

Over the summer holidays please ensure you read regularly with your child. Children love listening to stories and this will help with many aspects of their learning. If your child can blend sounds together, getting them to read simple words and phrases would be brilliant.



You can also practise the following sounds to ensure they are ready for when they come back in September.

Maths in Reception

In Reception, we will be aiming to have a deep understanding of numbers to 10 and how to use them. Over the summertime please practise counting up to and back from 10 and from any given number. You could also practise getting your child to recognise up to 5 objects without counting them.

Using the toilet independently.

Putting on your coat independently.

Using a knife, fork and spoon.

Taking turns in a game.

Expressing my emotions appropriatley to an adult.

Following simple instructions.


Asking and answering questions in a sentence.
