PE

<u>Class Dojo</u>

We will continue to use Class Dojo for communication. Your child/children will now be linked to their new year group and teacher.

School Gateway

We are in the process of setting up School Gateway for all pupils. This system is to move towards a cashless system in school and also works as a communication tool with regards to attendance. All bookings and payments for Breakfast/Afterschool clubs and extra-curricular clubs will be through this system. You will receive a separate letter about this. You will continue to pay for school dinners through School Grid.

School Dinners

School dinners, for Reception to Year 6, can be ordered several weeks in advance and all dinners should be ordered from home via School Grid. Orders need to be placed by 9am at the latest each day.

Parents of Year 3 pupils, please note that you will now need to pay for any school dinners ordered, as your child is no longer in receipt of 'Universal Infant Free School Meals'.

Nursery children who are in for full day sessions should bring a packed lunch. Further guidance regarding packed lunches is available on our website.

Reminder to all parents – please ensure your child does not bring any nuts or nut-based products into school due to us having nut allergy sufferers.

After-school Extra-Curricular Clubs

We will be running a range of after school clubs again this term. A letter will be sent out this week with details. Bookings and payments will be made through School Gateway and will be on a first come first served basis.

<u>Uniform</u>

At the end of Summer term, we sent home a letter regarding uniform. Can I just remind you of uniform expectations at Ellington:

School Uniform for September 2022:

- Navy blue/red jumpers/cardigans for EYFS and Years 1 to 4.
- Purple/navy jumpers/cardigans for Years 5 and 6.
- > White polo-shirts/shirt.
- Black or charcoal skirt, shorts or trousers.
- Red or blue summer dress.
- > Black school shoes or **plain** black trainers.

PE Kit for September 2022:

- School PE Kit consisting of a white t-shirt with embroidered badge and navy/black shorts Or
- Plain white t-shirt and plain navy/black shorts.
- Plain navy/black jogging bottoms.
- School PE hoody or plain navy hoody.
- > Children can wear any comfortable trainers on their PE day.

Space is very limited in the cloakrooms. Ideally, children in EYFS and KS1 will use a book bag every day except on PE days. This would help enormously!

I am sure all of the children will settle quickly back into school, but should you have any concerns or questions, please don't hesitate to contact your child's class teacher or myself. All teachers will be outside the classrooms every morning and home time.
