



## English

This half term will start with a book study of 'Mrs Mole I'm Home'. We will explore the story and think about how the Mole is feeling throughout the story, writing sentences with adjectives, and including the correct punctuation and grammar for year 1. We will then learn about the features of a Fact file. We will use our learning to create our own fact file about Moles. We will continue to work on our handwriting and full stops, capital letters and finger spaces.



## Science

In Science, this term we are studying the unit 'Animals.' During this unit we will explore the question: Are all animals the same? We will identify mammals, birds, fish, reptiles and amphibians and make comparisons between them. We will then move on to learning about carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.



## Maths

Maths lessons will continued to be structured following our new maths scheme 'Big Maths'. Each lesson will start with a CLIC session followed by the main session focusing on one of the following subjects; Telling the time to half past, Days of the week, Months of the year, comparing amounts of mass and weight and addition and subtraction up to 20.

## History

This term our topic is 'How have toys changed.' Sequencing toys into a physical timeline. Children will then investigate artefacts from the past. Then the children will learn about how teddy bears have changed, they interview one and consider what they will look like in the future.



## Computing

In the unit Maze explorers, children are learning the understand the functionality of the direction keys and how to create and debug a set of instructions. They will then use the direction keys as part of their own instructions (algorithm).



## Art

In this unit the children will create simple three dimensional shapes and structures using familiar materials. Introducing 3D art forms, focussing on techniques such as rolling paper tubes and constructing imaginative sculptures by manipulating card and paper.



## PE

This term PE taught by Mr Everett will focus on Dance with the theme of zoo animals. PE taught by Charlie will focus on Ball and hand skills.



## PSHE

This term we will be finishing of the unit Safety and the Changing body, discussing: appropriate contact, safety in the home, what to do in an emergency and people who help keep us safe. Then we will move onto Citizenship, learning about: rules, democratic decisions, the needs of others, belonging and differences.



## RE

Our key question for the whole of Spring Term is: Who is Jewish and how do they live?
