Martin is also a huge advocate for Mental Health. He has been running events to support Mental Health charities for a number of years and is working closely with Beyond (https://wearebeyond.org.uk/) to support the mental health of young people.

Beyond is a youth mental health charity tackling the growing mental health crisis affecting young people in the UK. They address the lack of access to support and create opportunities for early and personalised interventions. They use expertise and resources to help those working with young people access the right mental health support for those in their care.



Martin is a huge football fan and has yearly football charity games to raise money for Beyond. I recently played (poorly!) in his latest charity match which raised nearly £1000. On October 4th, we are inviting all children in school to wear a football shirt (if they have one) or to come in non-uniform for a £1 donation which will go directly to Beyond.
